DESCRIPTION

RULES

1. Full protective equipment required.
2. No offsides
3. No icing
4. No checking. Checking will result in a penalty shot for the opponent.
5. When the goalie freezes the puck or a goal is scored the puck will be played from behind the net to resume play. There will be no whistle.
6. Skaters will not be allowed into different age classifications.
7. All sessions will be supervised.
